They allow us an opportunity to learn with and from each other and so grow together - grow together into a community, a community of worship and of discipleship.

Harvest is an ideal time for realising that the gifts, the abilities which each of us has are all needed and can be brought to the community. Community is what we are called to be - helping and caring for each other and sharing with each other.

Holy Lord, teach us to learn from each other and care for each other.


Mall, causing heads to turn a little along the way.


